Alternative Dispute Resolution Updates

Preliminary

As of 30 September 2020

This ADR Update records in brief the collective accomplishments of NCMB as of September 2020.

I. PREVENTIVE MEDIATION (PM)

- 29 cases pending at the beginning of the year
- 206 new cases have been filed since January (46 cases filed in September)
- 235 total cases handled as of 30 September 2020
- Disposition rate: 78% (184 of the 235 total cases handled)
 - 116 cases disposed within the process cycle time (PCT = 35 days)
 - o 68 cases disposed beyond PCT
- Settlement rate: 76% (179 of the 235 total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 37 days
- 51 cases pending as of 30 September 2020
 - o 37 pending cases are 35 days old or younger
 - o 14 pending cases are older than the PCT
- Monetary benefits: Php88,532,129 benefitting 723 workers

II. NOTICES OF STRIKE/LOCKOUT (NS/L)

- 48 cases pending at the beginning of the year
- 60 new cases have been filed since January (5 cases filed in September)
- 108 total cases handled as of 30 September 2020
- Disposition rate: 62% (67 of the 108 total cases handled)
 - 46 cases disposed within the process cycle time (PCT = 60 days)
 - 21 cases disposed beyond PCT
- Five (5) cases materialized into actual strikes
- Settlement rate: 54% (58 of the 108 total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 96 days
- 41 cases pending as of 30 September 2020
 - 9 pending cases are 60 days old or younger
 - 32 pending cases are older than the PCT
- Monetary benefits: Php250,300,994 benefitting 6,203 workers
- Mandays saved: 985,005*

III. ACTUAL STRIKES/LOCKOUTS (AS/L)

- Six (6) cases pending at the beginning of the year
- Five (5) work stoppages have been monitored since January 2020
