

Alternative **D**ispute **R**esolution **Updates**

Preliminary

As of April 30, 2018

This ADR update records in brief the collective accomplishments of NCMB during the month of April 2018.

I. PREVENTIVE MEDIATION (PM)

- 33 cases pending at the beginning of the year
160 new cases filed since January (39 cases filed in April)
193 total cases handled as of April 30, 2018
155 net total cases handled (193 total cases handled less 38 pending cases within the process cycle time (PCT))
- Disposition rate: 88% (137 of the 155 net total cases handled)
 - 97 cases disposed within the process cycle time (PCT = 60 days)
 - 40 cases disposed beyond PCT
- Settlement rate: 86% (133 of the 155 net total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 29 days
- 56 cases pending as of April 30, 2018
 - 38 pending cases are 35 days old or younger
 - 18 pending cases are older than the PCT
- Monetary benefits : Php25,429,431 benefitting 1,075 workers

II. NOTICES OF STRIKE/LOCKOUT (NS/L)

- 31 cases pending at the beginning of the year
65 new cases filed since January (16 cases filed in April)
96 total cases handled as of April 30, 2018
70 net total cases handled (96 total cases handled less 26 pending cases within the process cycle time (PCT))
- Disposition rate: 67% (47 of the 70 net total cases handled)
 - 38 cases disposed within the process cycle time (PCT = 60 days)
 - 9 cases disposed beyond PCT
- Two (2) cases materialized into actual strike
- One (1) case certified for compulsory arbitration
- Settlement rate: 60% (42 of the 70 net total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 82 days
- 49 cases pending as of April 30, 2018
 - 26 pending cases are 45 days old or younger
 - 23 pending cases are older than the PCT

- Monetary benefits : Php157,570,346 benefitting 1,922 workers
 - Mandays saved: 774,780 *
- *computed as average strike duration for last five years multiplied by the number of workers involved in NS/L handled during the reporting period.

III. **ACTUAL STRIKES/LOCKOUTS (AS/L)**

- Two (2) work stoppages were monitored since January 2018
- Both work stoppages were settled/disposed
- Total man-days lost: 2,660
- Disposition rate: 100% (2 of the 2 strikes handled)
- Monetary benefits : Php1,684,103,754 benefitting 251 workers

VIII. WORKPLACE RELATIONS ENHANCEMENT

- 102 LMCs facilitated since January 2018 (32 in organized companies and 70 in unorganized companies)
- 765 LMCs enhanced (403 in organized companies and 362 in unorganized companies)

- 1,608 companies reached through promotional/pre-facilitation activities since January 2018
- 3,311 existing LMCs nationwide as of April 30, 2018 (1,503 in organized companies; 1,808 in unorganized establishments)
- 97.5% or 3,064 out of 3,144 companies with LMCs were not involved in AS/L, NS/L, PM cases during the period

IX. CONVERGENCE PROGRAM

- LMCs Enhanced through convergence programs since January 2018:
 - 244 LMCs enhanced through convergence program with NWPC (productivity), 240 LMCs in OSHC and ECC on occupational safety and 296 LMCs in health and with BWSC on family welfare program

- 71 GMs institutionalized in unorganized establishments
