Updates

Preliminary

As of July 31, 2018

This ADR update records in brief the collective accomplishments of NCMB during the month of July 2018.

I. PREVENTIVE MEDIATION (PM)

- 33 cases pending at the beginning of the year
 288 new cases filed since January (50 cases filed in July)
 321 total cases handled as of July 31, 2018
 285 net total cases handled (321 total cases handled less 36 pending cases within the process cycle time (PCT)
- Disposition rate: 95% (272 of the 285 net total cases handled)
 - 200 cases disposed within the process cycle time (PCT = 60 days)
 - o 72 cases disposed beyond PCT
- Settlement rate: 91% (259 of the 285 net total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 31 days
- 49 cases pending as of July 31, 2018
 - o 36 pending cases are 35 days old or younger
 - o 13 pending cases are older than the PCT
- Monetary benefits: Php54,862,977 benefitting 1,613 workers

II. NOTICES OF STRIKE/LOCKOUT (NS/L)

- 31 cases pending at the beginning of the year
 124 new cases filed since January (26 cases filed in July)
 155 total cases handled as of July 31, 2018
 120 net total cases handled (155 total cases handled less 35 pending cases within the process cycle time (PCT)
- Disposition rate: 78% (93 of the 120 net total cases handled)
 - o 70 cases disposed within the process cycle time (PCT = 60 days)
 - o 23 cases disposed beyond PCT
- Four (4) cases materialized into actual strike
- One (1) case certified for compulsory arbitration
- Settlement rate: 71% (85 of the 120 net total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 68 days
- 62 cases pending as of July 31, 2018
 - o 35 pending cases are 60 days old or younger
 - 27 pending cases are older than the PCT

- Monetary benefits: Php938,028,026 benefitting 7,311 workers
- Mandays saved: 1,232,310 *
 - *computed as average strike duration for last five years multiplied by the number of workers involved in NS/L handled during the reporting period.

III. ACTUAL STRIKES/LOCKOUTS (AS/L)

- Five (5) work stoppages were monitored since January 2018, one of which is a wildcat strike.
 - o Goodyear Steel Pipe Corp. (NCR) declared last January 30, 2018, affecting 270 workers was amicably settled last March 6, 2018.
 - o **Ateneo De Manila University** (NCR) declared on February 11, 2018 affecting 240 workers was amicably settled last February 23, 2018.
 - o **Middleby Philippines Inc.** (RCMB IV-A) declared on May 10, 2018, without the requisite notice of strike on issue of regularization, affecting 133 workers. Disposed on July 4, 2018
 - NutriAsia Inc. (RCMB III) declared on June 2, 2018, affecting 1,400 workers and was disposed on July 30, 2018
 - o Valencia Rubbertex Inc. (RCMB X) declared on July 25, 2018, affecting 231 workers.
- Four (4) net total cases handled (5 total cases handled less one pending case within the process cycle time (PCT)
- Four (4) work stoppages were disposed
- One (1) case pending as of July 31, 2018
 - o one pending case is 40 days old or younger
- Total man-days lost: 84,074
- Disposition rate: 100% (4 of the 4 net total cases handled)

Monetary benefits: Php1,684,103,754 benefitting 251 workers
