# Alternative Dispute Resolution

# **Updates**

### Preliminary

As of June 30, 2018

This ADR update records in brief the collective accomplishments of NCMB during the month of June 2018.

### PREVENTIVE MEDIATION (PM) 1.

- 33 cases pending at the beginning of the year 237 new cases filed since January (25 cases filed in June) 270 total cases handled as of June 30, 2018 250 net total cases handled (270 total cases handled less 20 pending cases within the process cycle time (PCT)
- Disposition rate: 92% (230 of the 250 net total cases handled)
  - 171 cases disposed within the process cycle time (PCT = 60 days)
  - 59 cases disposed beyond PCT
- Settlement rate: 89% (222 of the 250 net total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 30 days
- 40 cases pending as of June 30, 2018
  - 20 pending cases are 35 days old or younger
  - 20 pending cases are older than the PCT
- Monetary benefits: Php52,428,389 benefitting 1,504 workers

### NOTICES OF STRIKE/LOCKOUT (NS/L) 11.

- 31 cases pending at the beginning of the year 98 new cases filed since January (17 cases filed in June) 129 total cases handled as of June 30, 2018 104 net total cases handled (129 total cases handled less 25 pending cases within the process cycle time (PCT)
- Disposition rate: 75% (78 of the 104 net total cases handled)
  - $\circ$  58 cases disposed within the process cycle time (PCT = 60 days)
  - 20 cases disposed beyond PCT
- Three (3) cases materialized into actual strike
- One (1) case certified for compulsory arbitration
- Settlement rate: 68% (71 of the 104 net total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 74 days
- 51 cases pending as of June 30, 2018
  - o 25 pending cases are 60 days old or younger
  - 26 pending cases are older than the PCT

Monetary benefits: Php884,868,363 benefitting 6,815 workers

Mandays saved: 973,830 \*

\*computed as average strike duration for last five years multiplied by the number of workers involved in NS/L handled during the reporting period.

# ACTUAL STRIKES/LOCKOUTS (AS/L)

- Four (4) work stoppages were monitored since January 2018, one of which is a wildcat strike.
  - Goodyear Steel Pipe Corp. (NCR) declared last January 30, 2018, affecting 70 workers was amicably settled last March 6, 2018.

o Ateneo De Manila University (NCR) declared on February 11, 2018 affecting 245 workers was amicably settled last February 23, 2018.

o Middleby Philippines Inc. (RCMB IV-A) declared on May 10, 2018, without the requisite notice of strike on issue of regularization, affecting 133 workers.

o NutriAsia Inc. (RCMB III) declared on June 2, 2018, affecting 700 workers.

- Three (3) net total cases handled (4 total cases handled less one pending case within the process cycle time (PCT)
- Two (2) work stoppages were settled/disposed
- Two (2) cases pending as of June 30, 2018
  - o one pending case is 40 days old or younger
  - o one pending case is older than the PCT
- Total man-days lost: 23,779
- Disposition rate: 67% (2 of the 3 net total cases handled)

Monetary benefits: Php1,684,103,754 benefitting 251 workers

- 204 LMCs facilitated since January 2018 (38 in organized companies and 166 in unorganized companies)
