

Alternative Dispute Resolution Updates

Preliminary

As of 31 August 2023

This ADR Update records in brief the collective accomplishments of NCMB as of August 2023.

I. PREVENTIVE MEDIATION (PM)

- 13 cases pending at the beginning of the year
- 279 new cases have been filed since the start of the year (40 new cases filed in August)
- 292 total cases handled as of 31 August 2023
- Disposition rate: 84% (244 of the 292 total cases handled)
 - 196 cases disposed of within the process cycle time (PCT = 35 days)
 - 48 cases disposed of beyond PCT
- Settlement rate: 77% (226 of the 292 total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 24 days
- 48 cases pending by the end of August 2023
 - o 34 pending cases are 35 days old or younger
 - 14 pending cases are older than the PCT
- Monetary benefits: Php205,297,977 benefitting 2,814 workers

II. NOTICES OF STRIKE/LOCKOUT (NS/L)

- 25 cases pending at the beginning of the year
- 82 new cases have been filed since the start of the year (9 new cases filed in August)
- 107 total cases handled as of 31 August 2023
- Disposition rate: 79% (85 of the 107 total cases handled)
 - 44 cases disposed of within the process cycle time (PCT = 60 days)
 - 41 cases disposed of beyond PCT
- Settlement rate: 74% (79 of the 107 total cases handled)
- Average duration to settle: 150 days
- 22 cases pending as of 31 August 2023
 - 11 pending cases are 60 days old or younger
 - 11 pending cases are older than the PCT
- Monetary benefits: Php1,088,785,467 benefitting 7,119 workers

III. ACTUAL STRIKES/LOCKOUTS (AS/L)

- No pending case at the beginning of the year
- Two (2) work stoppages were monitored since the start of the year (1 work stoppage has been monitored in August 2023)
- Two (2) cases handled as of 31 August 2023

- Disposition rate: 92% (2,057 of the 2,233 total RFAs handled)

VI. WORKPLACE RELATIONS ENHANCEMENT

- 256 LMCs have been facilitated as of August 2023 (33 in organized company and 223 in unorganized companies)
- 1,652 LMCs enhanced (562 in organized companies and 1,090 in unorganized companies)
- 2,867 companies reached through promotional activities through LMC & GM as of August 2023
- 5,051 existing LMCs nationwide as of 31 August 2023 (1,624 in organized companies; 3,427 in unorganized establishments)
- 97.81% or 4,745 out of 4,851 companies with LMCs were not involved in AS/L, NS/L, PM cases during the period.
