This ADR Update records in brief the collective accomplishments of NCMB as of March 2024.

I. PREVENTIVE MEDIATION (PM)

- 27 cases pending at the beginning of the year
- 91 new cases have been filed since the start of the year (24 new cases filed in March)
- 118 total cases handled as of 31 March 2024
- Disposition rate¹: 71% (84 of the 118 total cases handled)
